How to Make Felt-Board Characters

The Lion Who Saw Himself in the Water



Use the pattern pieces to cut out the pieces for this scene. For help on making a felt board, see simple instructions on www.hoopoekids.com

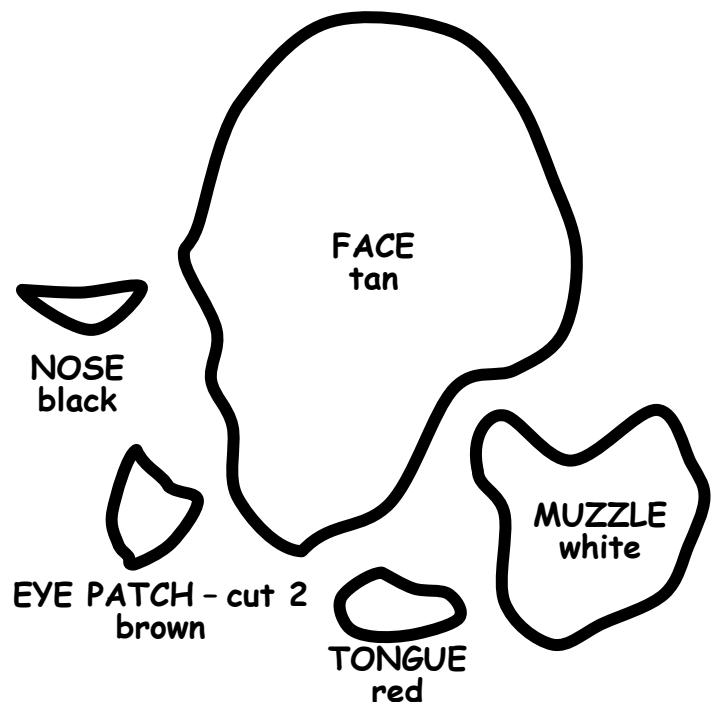
SUPPLIES:

1. Felt: black, brown, light-blue, light-orange, purple, red, tan, yellow and white
2. Good all-purpose glue or craft fabric bonding glue (works best!)
3. Markers, fine-point: black and other colors you want
4. Scissors

LION:

1. Cut out **BODY** and glue on **MANE**
2. Glue on **FACE, FRONT LEG** and **BACK LEG**
3. Glue on **MUZZLE** and **TOES**
4. Glue **TUFT** to tip of tail
5. Glue on each **EYE PATCH, TONGUE** and **NOSE**
6. Glue on each **EYE**
7. Draw the eyelid and pupil on each **EYE**
8. Draw the smile and whisker dots

For head & reflection, cut 2 of all head parts.

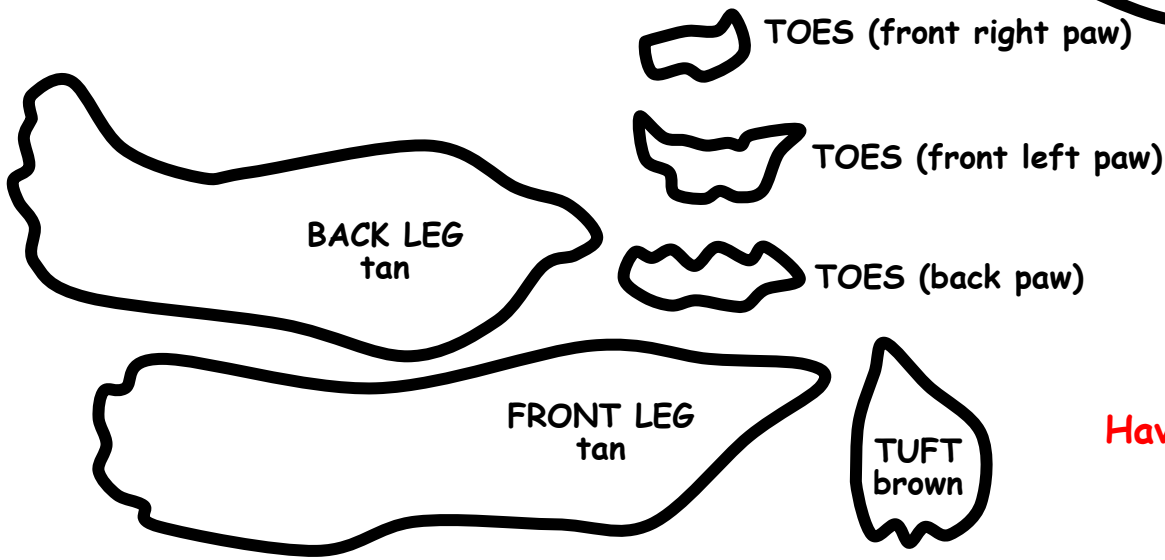
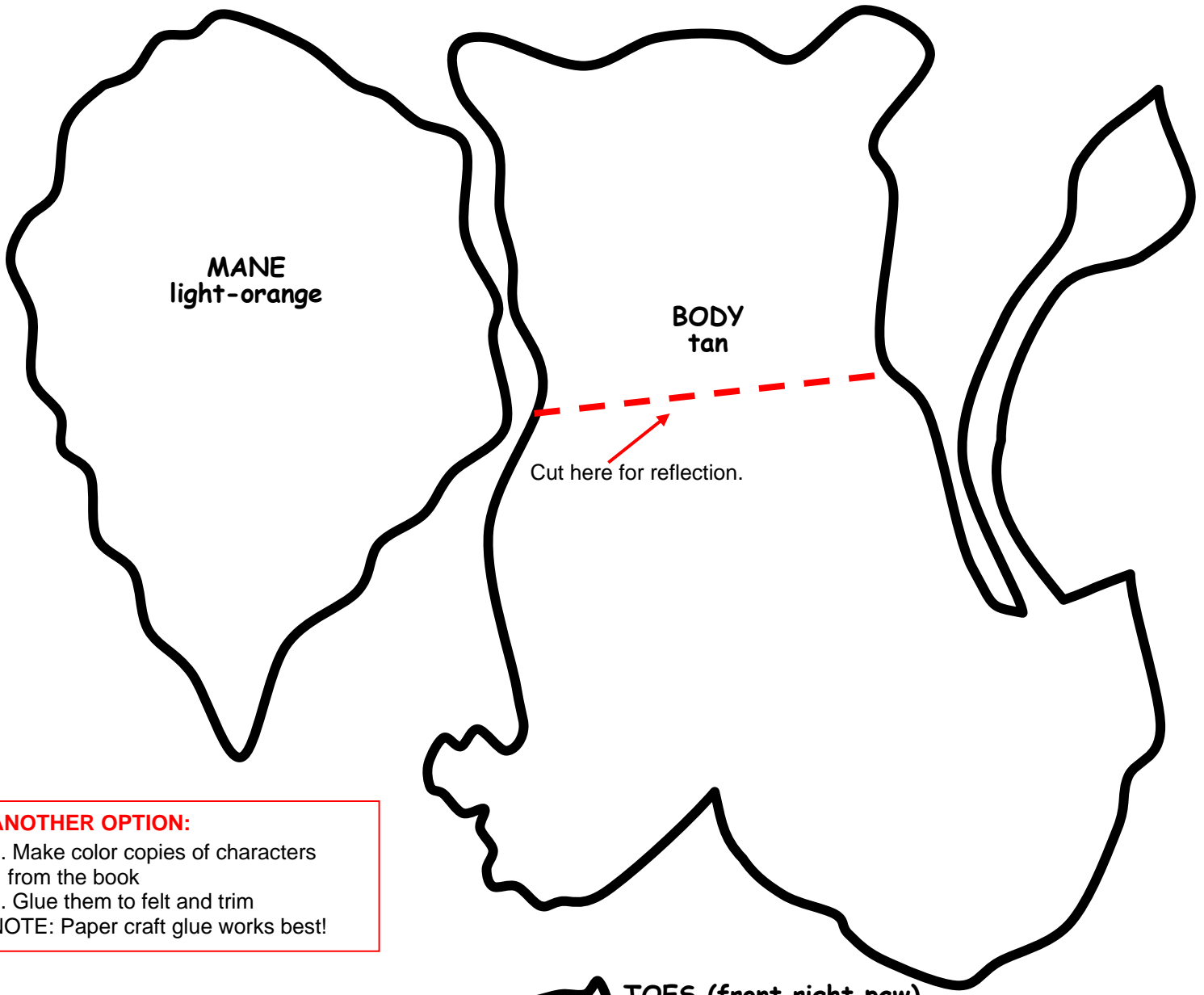


BUTTERFLY:

1. Glue one **WING** on top of other
2. Glue on **BODY**
3. Add decorations to each **WING**
4. Sew antennae on **BODY**

WATER:

1. Cut out water from light-blue felt
2. Add lion's head as reflection



Have fun!

CAUTION: Avoid injury! Adult supervision recommended, if necessary. This project includes cutting with scissors and using a sharp needle!
